

What is the Living Works Community Walk?

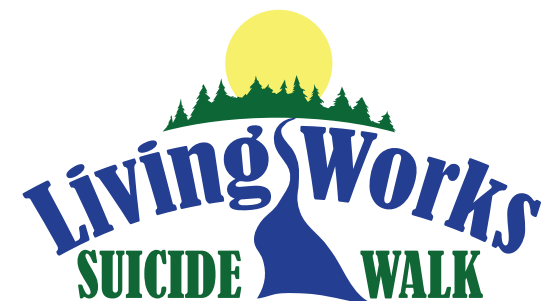
Living Works is dedicated to educating the community, to finding a way to provide needed services so that everyone can be safe from the tragedy of suicide, and to show that "Living Works."

We first walked in 2010 to raise money to educate the community on suicide prevention. The response was overwhelming as the community gathered to remember family and friends lost to suicide, to support those who are grieving, and to show that together, we really can make a difference.

We use the money we raise to conduct 90-minute suicideTALKs organized around the question "Should we talk about suicide?" and 3-hour safeTALKs to prepare anyone over 15 to identify persons at-risk, and help connect them to suicide first-aid resources.

We have also hosted several ASIST 2-day workshops in Princeton and Ottawa to help caregivers feel more confident to help prevent the immediate risk of suicide. Your participation in the Walk allows us to continue these efforts.

One goal is to attract mental health care professionals into the community so that those at risk for suicide can be treated locally. We are always seeking to partner with organizations that have complementary objectives. Our 501(c)3 status means your donations are tax deductible.

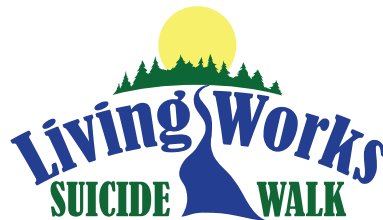
